Not long to go to the end of term – we hope that you've enjoyed our events this year and that the school and your children have benefited from our efforts. The installation of a new trim trail on the school field which we fundraised towards last year has certainly been a great success and has received lots of use at break times and after school.

This year, the school's Knight Sir Aquilam has really helped to raise the profile of the school in the Lincoln community and the whole school trip funded by FOES to see him launched at the Lincolnshire Show was a fabulous experience for everyone. Sir Aquilam is currently on display in the Waterside shopping centre in Lincoln and will join all the other Knights at a reunion at the end of the Trail programme before returning to the school.
