Thank you for all your donations of **used clothing** for our last collection. The next opportunity to donate your cast offs will be on <u>Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> June</u> so please continue to save items as you sort your wardrobes out during the year.

Our next Film Night has an Easter theme. It will be on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> March when we will show "Hop" (U) at the Village Hall. Hot Dogs, popcorn, sweets and drinks will be on sale too. The doors will open at 4:15 and the show will start at 4:30 so there will be time for anyone at afterschool MSP club to get round to the hall. The film will finish at approximately 6pm. Tickets are FREE but seating is limited – please use the flyer which has been sent home to book your tickets. Any surplus tickets will be available at the door.





FOES will hold our **AGM** on <u>Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> March</u> at 2:30. It's just before pick up so if you can come along a little bit early and join us in the school hall there will be free hot drinks and free cake too while we tell you what FOES have been up to the past year and what our plans are for the future.

As part of the AGM we will elect the FOES committee for next year and we hope that someone is prepared to take on the role of Treasurer. Jackie has most generously kept the position filled after her son left the school but she has other commitments and will step down at the meeting. FOES cannot operate without a Treasurer so please consider if you can spare some time (not a lot!) to volunteer to take Jackie's place. All the money that FOES fundraises goes to support the school so the children will lose out on resources and experiences if we are forced to fold.

FOES will hold a craft session during school time on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> March where the children can make a gift to give to their Mum for Mother's Day (or Gran or someone special). There will be a charge of £1.50 to cover materials and you can book your child onto the session using the flyer previously sent home from school.



Our **Cuppertino Café** will soon return after the Easter break when FOES will serve cakes and drinks on the school field at the end of the school day every Friday (so long as the weather is good!) We will start on <u>Friday 21<sup>st</sup> April</u> and then look forward to seeing you there every Friday in terms 5 and 6 except for a few exceptions when FOES are hosting other events - these are: 19<sup>th</sup> May, 16<sup>th</sup> June and 14<sup>th</sup> July.

Year 6 children will receive a free cake from the café on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May to celebrate the end of SATS and the café will also serve freeze pops on Frozen Fridays which are the last Friday of each month (28<sup>th</sup> April, 26<sup>th</sup> May and 30<sup>th</sup> June). Plus the café will be on the field on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> June at school sports day to serve treats and drinks to top up your picnic baskets alongside a used uniform sale.



We hope that your children enjoy the Smarties that FOES have sent home. Please save your loose change when you empty your pocket or purse and refill the tubes with spare change. When they are full, please return the tubes to the school office. Thank you.

FOES will provide every child at the school with an Atlas suitable for their age group as our contribution to World Book day. This legacy purchase will continue supporting children at the school in future years.
