

Admission Arrangements

Our school admissions arrangements are in accordance with the Local Authority as outlined in our policy and the www.lincolnshire.gov.uk/schooladmissions website.

This website allows you to apply on-line for a school place, either for the start of school or as a mid-year admission if you are moving to our school from another part way through the school year. Of course, we would love to hear from you too so that we can arrange for a school tour and offer you advice in relation to your admission if required.

Our school has a Published Admissions Number (PAN) of 12 pupils for each year group. Our setting allows for some flexibility in this number; however we always consider manageability of class sizes in the classrooms they will be working in before accepting pupils in excess of this year group number.

We have no specific selection criteria for applications and can offer advice in respect of school transport if you are joining or allocated our school from outside the village and how we can meet the needs of your child(ren). In the case of over-subscription, we would look at distance from school and siblings in the first case.

Admissions Process:

We like to keep it simple and we want you to pick the right school first time:

1. have a good look around the website to start to get to know us
2. call to arrange a visit or if that is not possible, just to chat over the phone
3. log on to www.lincolnshire.gov.uk/schooladmissions and click Apply Online
4. school responds electronically to the LA, who in turn contacts you
5. either prior to or on your first day we ask you to complete in school forms
6. when you arrive, you receive a complimentary book and PE bag
