So that you feel clear about the teaching and learning intentions for Summer Term 2017, please enjoy reading this overview. We hope that you find it helpful ...

Geography and history are the driving forces behind this project.

They will discover the castles around the British Isles. Find out about the most splendid ones and their locations around the UK. Capture the range of architecture using different art and craft techniques and conclude by meeting the Duke of Normandy and helping to plan his next castle!

Geography: Use geographical vocabulary, use maps, atlases and globes and devise a simple map with a key.

History: Find out about different types of castles; Motte and Bailey and Concentric. Learn their key features and about the main methods of attacking and defending them. Find out about life and jobs in a medieval castle.

Art: Create 3D castles and use 2D shapes to recreate a Paul Klee image.

I.T: Green screen, aerial photographs and videos,

Music: Listen to a range of music. Play tunes and untuned instruments.

Literacy: Information texts, legends, fiction writing and poetry.

Numeracy: Measurement: Time, Capacity, Volume and Temperature. Post Sat's work.

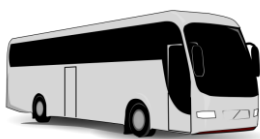
R.E: The Torah and the Bible.
