

Challenge Chasers

A project about record breakers by Year 5 and 6

Overview

In this focus for Upper Key Stage 2, the children undertook a Literacy, Maths and DT based project on WORLD RECORDS! The children formed a company called 'Challenge Chasers' and invited children in school to set Eagle records. These records were collated and a book made to celebrate the records achieved by our school. Certificates and photograph frames were designed and made to support a whole school display.

As part of their literacy they learnt how to write reports sharing the results of small challenges that they and children around the school did. Numeracy work involved data handling, as they gathered information and challenge results.

Facilitator Reflection

This was such an exciting project, with small challenges taking place in class, such as, 'How many Maltesers can you pick up with a straw in one minute?' The excitement and energy that was experienced in class was to be also found in the afternoon of challenges organised by the children for the rest of the school to have a go at.
