Today we have sent home an ICE card (R, Yr1, 2 &3) for you to leave in a handy place at home should your child ever need to call the emergency services. The ICE card was developed when a little girl had to call 999 after her mother had fallen ill. She had learnt her name, address and telephone number just in case an emergency ever happened. The characters on the front of the card are designed to help the child know who to ring and ask for, but also to let them have an indication of what the person MIGHT be wearing when they knock on their door at home and the vehicle they drive. Sharing some time talking about this and checking that your child knows all the important information will be time well spent.
