



## Statutory Assessments aka SATs

This is an opportunity for them to show us their learning across the Key Stage, but only for reading, writing, SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and maths – we recognise that this is just part of your child's learning journey. We want them to do as well as they can and so we are looking at ways to help them become comfortable with the format. This is their time to shine. ## E-Safety

Technology moves so quickly and new trends appear all the time. When we hear of something that you also may have come across or heard your children or older siblings talking about we like to share helpful information. Whilst some online games are not for children of our school age, there is often no proof of age required, so sometimes they are played. Fortnite: Battle Royale is PEGI rated at 12+, but requires no proof and comes with risks to children and young people. The game can expose children to violent content as well as inappropriate comments from older users.
