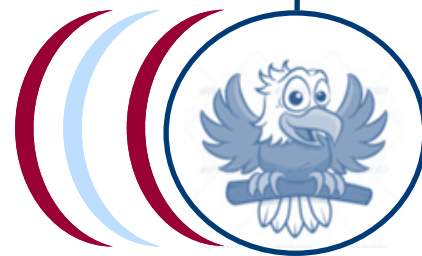


Little Eagles Newsletter
