Children in Need: Thank you for your generous donations which totalled £69.00. It was lovely to see the children dressing in yellow and/or spotty clothes for such a good cause.



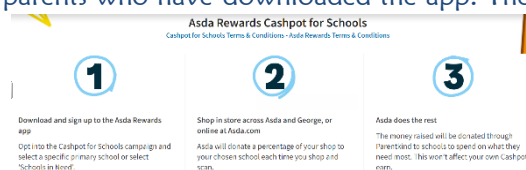
