2024/25 has seen Mrs Daley leading our school, driving us forward and implementing positive changes all round.

Successes we have seen this year include:

- New curriculum design and implementation. This is ensuring that children are building knowledge over time in a structured way with consistent lesson design across classes.
- Improved learning environments, including Learning Walls to help reinforce knowledge, vocabulary and develop independence whilst our children are learning.
- Early years development through planning and provision. Building an early years unit which also allows a seamless transition from nursery to reception.

We will continue to develop through consultation with staff and governors, self-evaluation, national changes to curriculum and assessment and recommendations for improvement from our last Ofsted inspection.

A great whole school trip to Yorkshire Wildlife park showed all our children representing our school with all our values and having a great time in the process.

Some of these opportunities would not be possible without Our Friends of Eagle School. The events they put on for the children and the parents such as pancake flipping, discos, race nights and seasonal fayres all support enriching the children's time and learning at our school. The next big thing that everyone will see in September will be the fresh new playground markings. Huge thanks go out to everyone who supports in anyway, it really does make a difference and keeps our school community thriving.

This year is no different to the others in the fact that it is the children who steal the show! As always they have continued to be excellent ambassadors with their continued display of 'Perseverance, Respect, Integrity, Diligence, Empathy' in and outside of school. Our most recent memorable show of this has to have been sports day: the children were amazing battling all weathers thrown at them and showing they are Team Eagle!

Our governing body is made up of 7 volunteers (myself included), Mr Watson our staff Governor and Mrs Daley our Head teacher.
