Key Facts

Key Vocabulary

Heroes: a person who is celebrated for their achievements
Superhero: a character who may have special powers
Past: what has happened
Future: what will happen
Job: what adults do to earn money to live
Challenge: What can you do towards your goal?
Words relating to occupations, such as: helmet, uniform, boss etc

Can you remember being a baby? What do babies do?
What job would you like to do when you grow up? What do you think that person does?
What would your super power be?
Can you make up a character?
What would their story be?
Can you investigate how a boat might work?
Can you think of ways of helping others?

Key Skills

Beginning to write a dictated sentence with your phonics skills.
Forming a deep understanding of numbers to ten including how to make these numbers.
Understanding weigh, length and capacity as a comparison and be able to measure these using non standard measures
Asking questions and making links with our learning
Improving fine motor skills to make representations of people and objects.
