- **Relax and Read** – Please send your child with their favourite book (please ensure they are named). Throughout the day a whistle will signal for the children to stop what they are doing and read for ten-minute slots.

- **Reception and Key Stage 1 Parent Volunteers** – if you wish to volunteer to read a story to your child's class then please let the class teacher know.
