The staff delivered *Speak Out, Stay Safe* assemblies. These important sessions helped children understand how to recognise worries, stay safe, and speak to a trusted adult if something doesn't feel right. As part of our ongoing commitment to keeping children safe online, pupils took part in an Internet Safety assembly delivered by Mr Watson.

Class 3 took part in Bikeability training this half term. The children developed their cycling confidence and road awareness, learning vital skills to help them ride safely and responsibly. Pupils across Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 also participated in dedicated road safety workshops. These sessions reinforced how to cross roads safely, understand traffic signals and make sensible choices near roads — all essential life skills.

Children across the school took part in engaging *Let's Talk Rubbish* workshops, learning about recycling, reducing waste and how we can all play a part in protecting our environment.

Our Little Eagle's children enjoyed a very special *Stay and Play* session themed around superheroes environment. Our youngest learners in Reception and Little Eagles have also been building their coordination and confidence through balance bike sessions.

We ended the half term with lots of laughter during our pancake flipping event! There were some impressive flipping skills on display — and a few pancakes that didn't quite make it back to the pan! A huge well done to everyone who took part in this light-hearted and enjoyable activity.
